

Are you prepared to save a life today?

This Stop the Bleed course is designed for civilians and first responders while giving them the knowledge and understanding of how to control both major and minor blood loss through the application of a tourniquet, wound packing, and direct pressure. This course will also explain the stages of shock and prevention of blood loss and why it is so critical in saving a life. Each student will also be taught the TCCC (Tacitcal Combat Casualty Care) acronym, MARCH, to help remember a basic treatment plan during high stressed situations.
